

Dear Students and Parents,

We already sent out a Technology Survey to evaluate and prepare for the first week of remote learning, which starts Monday, March 23. Here are some things to keep in mind while preparing for next week:

Schedule - With school not being in session, trying to keep a school schedule can be challenging. Your son/daughter can do this! Instructors should be sending an email regarding your virtual classes. Students will need check their ACES email for the Zoom link before classes start Monday morning and “attend” class. Just click the Zoom link to enter your virtual classroom. Class time is used to complete assignments and engage with their professors. *Students need to be dressed appropriately and act accordingly while in the virtual classroom.* **All students are expected to check-in with the Academy staff via Remind at the beginning of class time.**

Communication - All of our communication is being sent through Remind to keep you up to date with information; however, please feel free to reach out to us by phone or via email and we will do our best to assist you.
